Uncommon in shaded deciduous undergrowth within mature forests, often along streams or in low areas. A relatively small warbler, with long thin tail. Plain gray upperside unique. Also note neat white eye-ring, yellow supraloral, and "necklace" of streaks on breast. **Voice**: Song a sputtery descending jumble of high, clear, liquid notes mixed with sharp chips. Call a sharp dry *tyup*. Flight call a relatively low, liquid *plik*.
